



Camp CHLA Frequently Asked Questions

Can I apply if I'm a senior?

No, Camp CHLA is only available to high school students who are currently freshman, sophomores, or juniors during the time of the application process.

I live in a City/State outside of Los Angeles County, am I eligible to apply?

At this time, we are only accepting applications from students within Los Angeles County. Applications that do not meet our eligibility requirements will not be considered.

If I applied for Camp CHLA one year and did not get selected, can I submit the same application to be considered for Camp CHLA the following year?

We absolutely encourage applicants who have not previously been selected to apply again! You will need to submit a new application to be considered and similarities to your previous application are up to your discretion.

I did not learn about Camp CHLA until after the deadline, can I do anything to attend?

Unfortunately, you will have to wait until the following year to apply as we cannot make any exceptions to our application process. Please note that students who will be seniors next summer and missed this year's application deadline are not eligible for the program.

Can I miss school to attend?

We do not recommend missing school to attend camp. However, if camp coincides with your school schedule, that decision is at the discretion of you and your parents/guardians.

Can I get volunteer hours for school for attending camp?

No, this is not considered a volunteer experience. Camp is an opportunity to explore exciting careers within the health care field.
